Open Door Policy

Whitikahu School operates an open door policy. If you have a concern we encourage you to come to school and discuss it with us—we can then act upon it. The best time to see teachers is before or after school; Trish may be teaching Room 1 or in other rooms working to release teachers. The best time to see her is between 8:00-8:30am; after school or check with the office for an appointment. If you have an urgent concern we will always make time to see you—your concerns are important to us. You are welcome to come into school and see programmes in action—just check with the teacher first. If you feel this process does not meet your needs please follow the policy / procedure set out below.

CONCERNS AND / OR COMPLAINTS POLICY / PROCEDURE

Parents or Caregivers

To provide parents / caregivers with procedures to follow if they have a concern or complaint and to ensure the school responds in a clear and consistent manner.

Process:

- 1. Any concern or complaint is initially discussed with the class teacher (or Principal) at a time suitable to both that teacher and the parent / caregiver.
- 2. If, after seeing the class teacher, the parent / caregiver is not satisfied with the response, s/he is to contact the Principal.
- 3. If parents / caregivers still feel their concern or complaint has not been resolved satisfactorily, they can write a letter to the Board of Trustees.
- 4. Complaints against the Principal must be made in writing to the Board of Trustees Chairperson.
- 5. Outside agencies such as NZEI, the Ministry of Education and the Community Law Centre can be asked for advice in an effort to resolve the issue.

Procedures for parents to follow when they have a concern or complaint should be distributed annually at the beginning of each year either as part of the newsletter or in the initial parent interviews.
